Find enclosed the entry form for the upcoming Western Nugget Hereford Show slated for Dec. 2-4, 2010. The show schedule will be Junior Show – Thursday, December 2; Open Show Females – Friday, Dec. 3; and Open Show Bulls – Saturday, Dec. 4. All shows will start at 9:00 a.m. at the Reno Livestock Event Center. Cattle must arrive on the grounds between Tuesday Nov. 30 at 8:00 a.m. and Thursday Dec. 2 at 8:00 a.m. Animals arriving earlier will be charged a daily stalling fee.

Please note following: The Western Nugget Hereford Show is a “Stand Alone Event”, so there are no admission or parking fees nor do we charge for blocking chutes. **We will once again be providing supplemental power, enabling exhibitors to appropriately fit their cattle.**

All animals entering Nevada, must have a health permit issued by a licensed veterinarian within the 30 days of the show. The 2010 blanket health permit number for the Western Nugget Hereford Show and Sale is: **AB 091010-7988.**

Junior exhibitors may show in both the open and junior show, to do so, they must submit entry forms and pay entry fees for both. Please contact Lawrence or Buffy Goss as 530/993-4291 to request a junior entry form.
