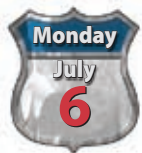

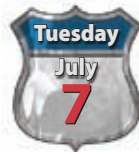
- 8 a.m. Outdoor tie spaces available for early arriving cattle

- 7:30 p.m. State delegate meeting, followed by candidate round table and meet-the-candidates dinner



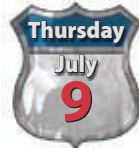
- 7 a.m. – Noon Finish processing cattle – all cattle must be in the barn and processed by noon
