### Bloodtyping to discontinue


After Jan. 1, 2009, bloodtyping for parentage verification will not be available. This change means that any sire or dam that has been bloodtyped and not had DNA collected will not be available to qualify as an artificial insemination (AI) sire or embryo transfer (ET) dam.
