The bred-and-owned bull show was sponsored by GeneSource and Bar A Cattle Co., Schulenburg, Texas.

Matt Copeland, Nara Visa, N.M., sorted 73 bulls to name the champions.

Effling's bull, CHEZ/PUGH/HARA Logic 8815F ET, won grand and division IV champion. He was a Feb. 23, 2018, son of CRR 719 Catapult 109.

The reserve champion bull, BR Belle Air E133 ET, was first named division V champion. He is a Nov. 30, 2017, son of BR Belle Air 6011. He is owned in partnership with Sidwell Herefords, Carr, Colo.

Shelton's reserve grand champion steer, DEP Venus Solution 189 ET, weighed in at 1,263 pounds for a WDA of 2.7, was sired by DEP Good & Plenty ET, and bred by Austin Deppe, Maquoketa, Iowa.
