

# Chapman, Vickland, Phillips and May Take Owned Female Show Honors

Grand and reserve grand female champions were selected after 225 horned heifers and 509 polled heifers were exhibited in the owned female show at the 2019 VitaFerm® Junior National Hereford Expo July 13 in Denver.

Topping the horned owned heifer show was Victoria Chapman, Mannsville, Okla., with BK Enchanting Points 7522E ET, a Nov. 7, 2017, daughter of CRR 5280 after first winning horned division VI champion.

Tripp Phillips, Mt. Pleasant, Texas, won reserve grand champion horned owned female with BR Baize F042 ET, after first being named horned division III champion. She was an April 25, 2018, daughter of BR Belle Air 6011.

Jarold Callahan of Yukon, Okla., and associate Donnie Robertson, also of Yukon, judged the owned show.

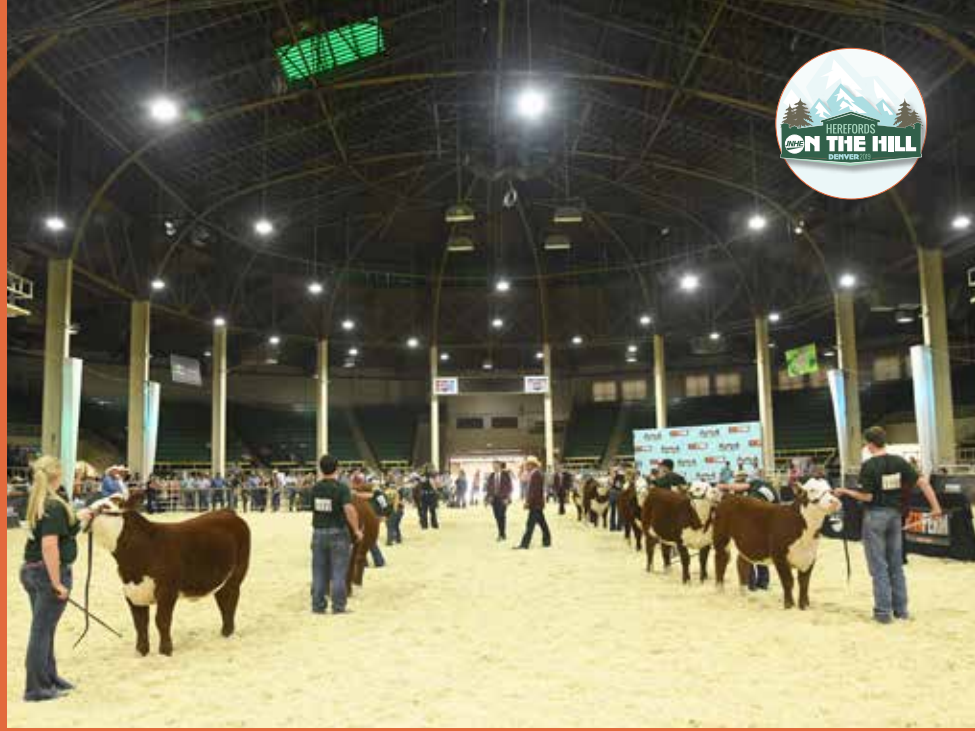
