


BQA Certification Instructions – NJHA Fed Steer Shootout

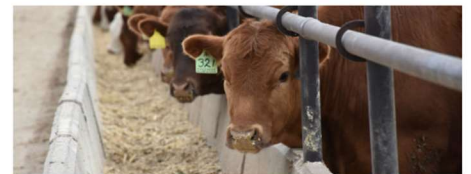
3. Once your account is created, log into the dashboard and select the “COW/CALF CERTIFICATION” course


