

**2020 Western States National Hereford Show**  
**December 3-5, 2020**  
**Reno, Nevada**

**The Western States Hereford Association is working hard to enable a successful show in 2020. To hold a show this year we must comply with standards outlined by the state of Nevada and Washoe County Health Department. Those requirements due to Nevada Covid-19 restrictions are outlined in the letter from WSHA President, Brian Gallagher: An adult representative from each family/ranch/crew must sign the compliance letter and return it to WSHA prior to the show.**

**All Western States National Hereford Show entries will only be accepted online.**

To complete your entry, go to the Western States Hereford Show and Sale website [www.HerefordReno.com](http://www.HerefordReno.com) and click on the Entry Button which will take you to this site: <https://www.BlueRibbonFair.com/BRFairProd/BlueRibbonStart.aspx?ID=2245>. You will then be able to set up your exhibitor information and enter classes for your cattle. Entry fees must be paid through this site with Visa and Mastercard being accepted forms of payment. Again for 2020: Pen of 3 bulls. Each bull must be entered as an individual with one entry to the Pen 3 Bulls class, but there is no additional entry fee for the pen class. Premium money will be awarded for the pen show, which will be held at the beginning of the bull show on Friday, December 4 at 9:00 a.m. Junior exhibitors may show in both the open and junior show, to do so, they must submit entries and pay fees for both.

The show schedule will be: Junior Show – Thursday, December 3, Open Show Bulls – Friday, December 4, and Open Show Females – Saturday, December 5. All shows will start at 9:00 a.m., at the Reno Livestock Event Center Main Arena. Cattle must arrive on the grounds between Tuesday December 1 at 8:00 a.m. and Wednesday December 2 at 10:00 a.m. Animals arriving prior to Tuesday will be charged an additional daily stalling fee. The RLEC will be available for arrival on Sunday, November 30 after 8:00 a.m.

All cattle will be stalling in Barn #1 (which consists of the permanent box stalls, which are 12' X 12' with a sliding door) with overflow in the adjacent box stall barns. Exhibitors must provide shavings for bedding (NO STRAW). Shavings must be raked out of your stalls into the center aisle at the end of the show. There will be a \$20 charge per box stall which you must request with your entries. One tack stall per group will be provided at no charge. Stalls can be requested on your checkout screen. There will not be tie-outs available this year and the cutting arena is not available. Additional power will not be supplied this year, so if you have a generator, please plan to bring it with you.

The Livestock Pavilion will be used as a staging area on show days and is available on show days only. It is not available for use prior to Thursday.

All animals entering Nevada must have a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days. (exception - certificates must be issued within 14 days for VS affected states) and **all health certificates must be reviewed by our show/sale veterinarian prior to entering Nevada**. Our show/sale veterinarian is Dr. Tanya Balaam with Sierra Valley Large Animal Veterinary Services. Either you or your veterinarian will need to email your completed health certificate to Dr. Balaam at [office@sierravalleylavs.com](mailto:office@sierravalleylavs.com) prior to Monday November 23, 2020.
