

FUTURE PROFESSIONALS CONTEST

The objective of the contest is for NJHA members to create a resume based on factual work, experiences, education, etc., of the junior that can be used for future career and educational purposes. Resumes will be judged prior to the Junior National Hereford Expo each year.

RULES

1. Contestants must be a member of the National Junior Hereford Association.
2. All work must be of that entrant.
3. A PDF of the entry must be uploaded to the electronic contest entry form:
 - File name must include first initial and last name, i.e. J_DoeResume or J_DoeEssay

4. Resumes cannot have been presented for competition at a previous JNHE.

PROCESS

1. A panel of qualified judges will critique the entries.
2. Resumes will be critiqued on the following:
 - Organization
 - Content
 - Grammar
 - Categories Used
 - Relevance
 - Layout and Format
3. There will be different topics for intermediate and senior divisions.
4. The top senior and intermediate applicants will be required to attend the JNHE for a live interview with industry leaders and professionals on **Monday, July 5**.
5. Contestants are encouraged to wear business professional clothing.

TOPICS

1. Intermediate contestants will submit a cover letter and resume tailored towards applying for a scholarship
2. Senior contestants will apply for **one** of the three following positions:

1. First place in each age division will receive a \$500 scholarship
