2022 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

- Official ID required (i.e. metal tag, registration tattoo with papers)
- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days prior to entry
- Livestock exhibiting signs of any infectious, contagious, or communicable disease such as, but not limited to, warts, ringworm, pinkeye, or foot rot ARE NOT ELIGIBLE for exhibition.
- Special import requirements for MICHIGAN (see below)

MICHIGAN EXHIBITORS

Import Permit shall be obtained and recorded on CVI by issuing veterinarian at 502-782-5901, plus ALCONA/ALPENA/MONTMORENCY/OSCODA COUNTIES: Whole herd Tuberculosis (TB) test on all animals twelve (12) months of age and older within one (1) year of movement & incoming animal(s) two (2) months of age and older tested within sixty (60) days of entry, unless originating from an TB Accredited Herd.

OFFICIAL CATTLE IDENTIFICATION OPTIONS

- AIN 840 Tags (Animal Identification Number, Yellow Tags that begin with the official country code (840 for U.S.), followed by 12 digits. Must be purchased from vet.
- NUES 9/Silver Tags: Producers, Vets and markets can order National Uniform Ear Tagging System (NUES) from the state's vet office.
- Brucellosis Tags (Female cattle only). Orange RFID AIN tags from vet after Brucellosis vaccination.
- White 840 RFID (Female cattle only). Tags begin with 840 followed by 12 digits.

All requirements listed here must be listed on Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by accredited veterinarian within 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY.
