





VITAFERM® JUNIOR NATIONAL HEREFORD EXPO MAD DASH TO THE HEREFORD BASH | MADISON, WIS. 2023 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

ALL CATTLE

All cattle showing at the Junior National Hereford Expo (JNHE) must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) documenting official animal ID and all required tests and certifications including current accreditation number if applicable.

CATTLE FROM WITHIN WISCONSIN

Cattle from within Wisconsin have no requirements for tests.

CATTLE FROM OUTSIDE WISCONSIN

Cattle from outside Wisconsin MUST have at least one form of official ID (including steers).

Acceptable ID's for all cattle from outside Wisconsin include:

- USDA metal ear tag number that is part of the National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES)
- 15-digit "840" tags (visual or RFID)
- Valid only if applied before March 11, 2015:
 - Manufacturer-coded RFID tag 15-digit number with the first three digits in 900s
 - American ID tag 8 to 12-digit number prefaced with "USA"

BRUCELLOSIS REQUIREMENTS FOR CATTLE FROM OUTSIDE WISCONSIN

No current Brucellosis vaccination or testing requirements.

TUBERCULOSIS REQUIREMENTS FOR CATTLE FROM OUTSIDE WISCONSIN

- As of 2/1/2023 negative individual TB tests within 60 days before entering Wisconsin or origination from a currently TB
 accredited herd for all cattle regardless of age or sex are required for cattle if they are coming from TEXAS or MICHIGAN'S TB
 FREE ZONE.
- Cattle from MICHIGAN'S MODIFIED ACCREDITED (MA) ZONE (COUNTIES OF ALCONA, ALPENA, MONTMORENCY, AND OSCODA) currently require:
 - Negative whole-herd TB tests within 12 months before arrival in Wisconsin for all animals 1 year and older
 - Negative individual TB tests within 60 days before entering Wisconsin
 - Must return directly to the state of origin after the show, and there must be a statement on the CVI that they will be
 doing so
 - Import permit. Information on obtaining an import permit:
