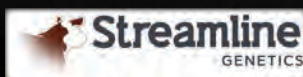

# 2023 Buckeye Hall of Merit

## Liz Core Awarded 2023 Buckeye Hereford Hall of Merit

Liz Core of the Core Farm Polled Herefords was awarded the 2023 Hall of Merit at the Buckeye Hereford Association's annual banquet on February 4th. The Core Farm is a family farming operation that was established in 1909 by Liz's great-grandfather, Isaac Core, in Logan County, Ohio. Liz's grandfather, Edward Core, brought the first Herefords to the family farm in the 1940s. Liz developed a great love for the breed growing up raising and showing Herefords with her family.

Several notable purchases were made in the early days of the Core Farm from Ohio's first Hall of Merit recipient, C.E. Knowlton, including CEK Mixer 50 and the record selling bull of the times CEK Superfactor 22. In more recent years Liz selected a number of cattle from the Remitall Polled Hereford dispersal in 2008 to boost performance in the herd. Liz in addition to being a good stockman, has always been a great steward of the land implementing many conservation

improvements to the farm over the years. Although showing has not been a focus for Liz she has entered cattle a number of times at the Buckeye Hereford Spring Show & Sale where they have been well received including a high selling bull one year. The farm is currently home to approximately 55 Hereford brood cows.

Liz has been active with the Buckeye Hereford Association, The Ohio Hereford Women and the Logan County Cattleman's Assoc., and SWCD among others. She has served many years as a Director for the BHA and OHW as well as serving as the President of the Ohio Hereford Women. Liz donates her time tirelessly to both organizations. Whether she is a current board member or not she is always one

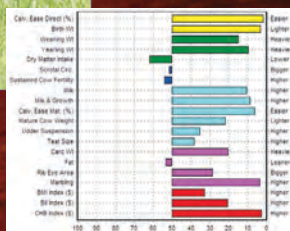

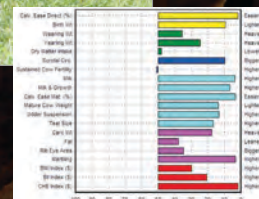

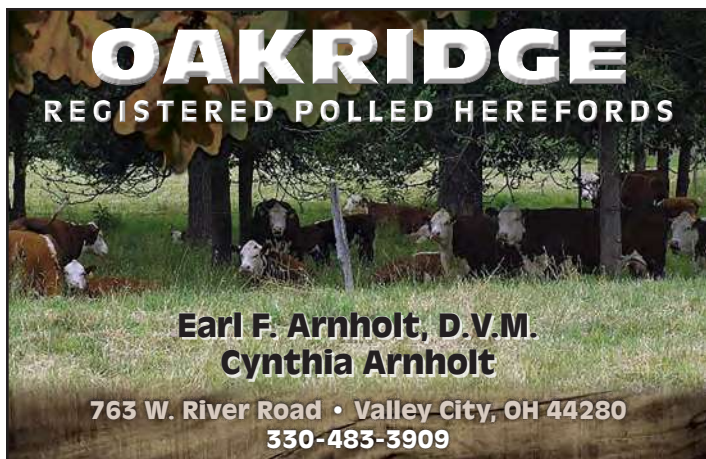
