Download Data from a saved Animal List using MyHerd.

This month, we'll explore more specific functions within the MyHerd search tools. Specifically, we will review a couple different features you can use with the Animal Lists.

Download Animal Lists

MyHerd users can download and save data on animals from Animal Lists. First, hover over the Search Tools menu and select Animal Lists. Click the saved Animal List you want to view and download. Select "Download Data."

Please note the "Download Data" button will automatically download a spreadsheet with 112 datapoints for your owned animals; unowned animals' data included in the saved Animal list is limited to ratios. Note that clicking on the "Download CSV" button will simply download the information

currently displayed on the screen. After you click "Download Data," an Excel file will download. Select and open the downloaded file. Once the Excel spreadsheet is open, use the scroll bar at the bottom of the spreadsheet to scroll to the right to see the available data.

Use Animal Lists to search

Animal Lists can also be used to do an Animal Search to retrieve the specified data and traits on a particular set of animals included in the list. On the Animal Search page click "Saved Animal Lists;" then select "Choose Animal Lists." In the pop-up box, click the box to the left of whichever list you're wanting to use to search with and then click "Load."

Select the criteria you want to show in your search results by

clicking the eye icon next to that field. Remember, if the eye icon is blue that means that criteria will show. If the eye icon is black, that means that criteria is turned off and you will not see those results. Once you've selected all your search criteria for that saved list of animals, scroll back up towards the top of the page, and click "Search." You can then click "Download CSV" to get an Excel file with all the data from your search results.
