WALTER & JOE LEWIS MEMORIAL HIGH-POINT SENIOR AWARD

One of the most coveted and historic awards at the Junior National Hereford Expo is the "Walter and Joe Lewis Memorial Award." The Walter and Joe Lewis Award will be awarded to the high point senior competitor at the current Junior National Hereford Expo, recognizing overall achievement in leadership, teamwork, skills and competition and will be presented at the conclusion of the annual event

A scholarship for \$1,000 will be awarded. The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university. If a high school senior wins the high point award, the scholarship will be paid upon enrollment to college.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Recipient must be in the senior division, ages 18-22 by Jan. 1 of the current year.

2. Applicant must be enrolled in college prior to receiving funds.

PROCESS

1. Selection of the award relies on a point system for participation in junior programs and activities.

SCORING SYSTEM

1. Individual Competition: The award recipient is required to compete in at least four of these six individual competitive events at the JNHE. These events, and scoring for them, are:
