HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ANIMALS

- All exhibitors must comply with the State of Kentucky Livestock Health Requirements.
- Representatives of the State Veterinarian's Office will be in attendance to verify CVIs.
- All animals entering the Kentucky Expo Center will be subject to examination by a veterinarian or a representative of the State Veterinarian's Office upon arrival or during the show.
- Livestock exhibiting signs of any infectious, contagious, or communicable disease, such as, but not limited to, warts, ringworm, pinkeye, or foot rot ARE NOT ELIGIBLE for exhibition and will be refused entry.
- BVD testing is NOT required.

CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI)

- All animals entering the Kentucky Expo Center must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)
- CVI must be issued by an accredited licensed veterinarian and issued within 30 days of the exhibition
- Official identification for each animal must be listed on the CVI. Forms of Official ID include:
 - » Individual animal breed registry tattoos
 - » Steel tags
 - » 840 RFID tags
- CVIs must list Kentucky Expo Center, Louisville, Ky., as the destination.
- Show name and address of owner or exhibitor.
- Show all required tests and/or vaccinations.

ALL MICHIGAN BEEF CATTLE

- **Import Permit** shall be obtained and recorded on the CVI by issuing veterinarian at 502-573-0282.
- **Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency and Oscoda Counties:** Whole herd Tuberculosis (TB) on all animals 12 months of age and older within one year of movement and incoming animal(s) two months of age and older tested within 60 days of entry, unless originating from a TB Accredited Herd.
